Description: Provides parts and supplies for the Roads Department; performs directly related work as required. The principal function of an employee in this class is to provide parts and supplies for the Roads Department. The work is performed under the supervision and direction of the County Engineer, but considerable leeway is granted for the exercise of independent judgement and initiative. The nature of the work performed requires that an employee in this class establish and maintain effective working relationships with the County Administrator, other County employees, and the general public. The principal duties of this class are performed in a work shop environment.
